On Friday, August 18th from 15:00 to 19:00 we invite you to spend a pleasant afternoon **in the beautiful garden of Teatr KTO**, where you will experience an informal workshop of the international theatre team of the creators of the ICEBREAKING project (SK+CZ+HU+UA+PL) **about interpersonal bonding for families with children from PL and UA**. Together and creatively we will celebrate our common neighbourhood 😊

Several of us have been meeting our new neighbours from Ukraine on our street for some time now. Many of us have given and are still giving them a helping hand. In turn, you, our new Ukrainian neighbours, have become helpful to us and enrich our Polish society/community with your knowledge, important services or professions. We have become each other's new neighbours. It is time for us to get to know each other better, to grow closer and to celebrate together that we are a gift to each other! How to do this?

All you have to do is to bring to celebration a symbolic GIFT that describes you personally (e.g. Jana has a dried four-leaf clover, because she has the nickname Clover, Tomáš has a book about Winnetou, which he still reads with pleasure, Emu has a DVD of her favourite A. Holland, Peter's hippie shirt and Jan loves red onions. We are all different, so the gift you choose will be unique because it will represent you. At the same time, **everyone will also receive a gift** :)

During the workshop, we will guide you through the journey of being generous and knowing how to give to a stranger. You will get better at being able to accept a gift from a stranger. You will experience the playful, fun and detective process of how to track down the anonymous donor who gifted you in a pile of gifts and donors, how to weave your way to them using only wrapping paper or ordinary string. At the end of this experience, you will find just your donor and get to know your new neighbour. The workshop also includes an informal picnic with conversation, good music and dancing.
